



OVERHEAD TRAVELLING CRANE OPERATOR SAFETY COURSE FOR CRANES 2000-4550 KG

- PURPOSE:** This course was designed to provide Crane Operators with the minimum industry training requirements to ensure safe and efficient operations. The course focuses on providing the foundation for meeting compliance requirements.
- MATERIALS:** Training material includes a printed manual.

QUALIFICATIONS:** Course instructors have operator training and extensive knowledge of the subject, and a demonstrated ability to resolve problems related to the subject.
- REQUIREMENTS:** Over one and one half days, participants are required to attend 8 hours of classroom instruction, one half hour each per participant for a practical evaluation and include complete a multiple-choice exam. The passing grades for the exam and the practical evaluation are 70%. Successful participants will be issued a Safety Training Certificate.
